Job Summary

The primary responsibility of the Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) Inspector is to perform field inspections of erosion and sediment control measures on roadway, bridge, and building construction projects in accordance with each project's approved SWPPP.

The Inspector must have a working knowledge of erosion and sediment control practices as they relate to construction activities. Project-specific training will be provided.

Many projects are located throughout Ohio, Northern Kentucky and Eastern Indiana and include Ohio Department of Transportation, county, and municipal roadway and bridge projects. The Inspector must be prepared to travel regularly, drive long distances, and operate company vehicles. A valid driver's license and acceptable driving record are required.

The Inspector will report to the Field Operations Manager and coordinate closely with project designers. Responsibilities include documenting field conditions, communicating inspection findings, and recommending SWPPP revisions or corrective actions when necessary.

The Inspector position is a full-time salaried position. Work hours will vary throughout the construction season and may include early mornings, extended workdays, and weather-driven scheduling to meet project and inspection requirements.

Minimum Requirements

- Minimum of two-year associate degree in environmental technology, construction, construction management, or a related field. Relevant work experience may be accepted in place of a degree.
- Applicants must obtain CPESC and/or CESSWI certification prior to employment. Coyle SWPPP Professionals is committed to helping qualified candidates achieve certification by providing application assistance, study materials, and guidance throughout the certification process.
- Proficiency with computers and common software applications, including Microsoft Office.
- Ability to communicate professionally with project staff, contractors, designers, and clients.
- Ability to work outdoors in varying terrain and weather conditions.
- Previous heavy highway or construction inspection experience is preferred.
